The opening on Tuesday did not feel like the old days of a crush at the door. There were maybe half the people, which gave more space to see the art and a better chance of talking to the dealers and other art world regulars.

There was certainly plenty of buying, whether from collectors IRL or pre-sales from PDFs. Speaking of IRL, there was a sense that this could be it for a while if new COVID cases spiral. A well-informed source, a senior fair-type in the past, thought they made it just in time, by maybe a week or two.

Prices seemed to be active up through \$1 million or \$1.5 million. Galleries played it safe and secure and were rewarded, for the most part. A year ago the dominant curatorial approach was about beauty; this year the works (almost all of which were paintings) were more angst oriented.

The Baer Faxt Recap: Asia's Auction Week

The Worlds In A Hand and 20th / 21st Century Art Evening Sales on December 1 at **Christie's** Hong Kong together totaled HK\$1.5 billion / US\$193 million, the second highest evening sale total for Christie's Asia. With 96% sold by lot, masterpieces by **Jean-Michel Basquiat**, **Gerhard Richter**, and **Sanyu** each fetched over HK\$100 million, while a world auction record was set for **Yayoi Kusama** with the sale of *Pumpkin* (*LPASG*) for HK\$62.5 million / US\$8 million.

Phillips and **Poly Auction**'s 20th Century & Contemporary Art Sale in Hong Kong totaled HK\$670 million / US\$86 million with 95.5% of lots sold. The highest price fetched in the evening sale was **Gerhard Richter**'s *Kerzenschein (Candle-light)* for HK\$101.9 million / US\$13 million.

China Guardian Auctions' Impressionist and Modern Art Evening Sale totaled ¥240 million / US\$37.6 million and the Contemporary Art Night Sale totaled over ¥49 million / US\$7.7 million. Liu Yiqian (Founder of Long Museum in Shanghai) bought the Claude Monet, The Rose Arches at Giverny, for ¥154.1 million / UD\$24.2 million.
